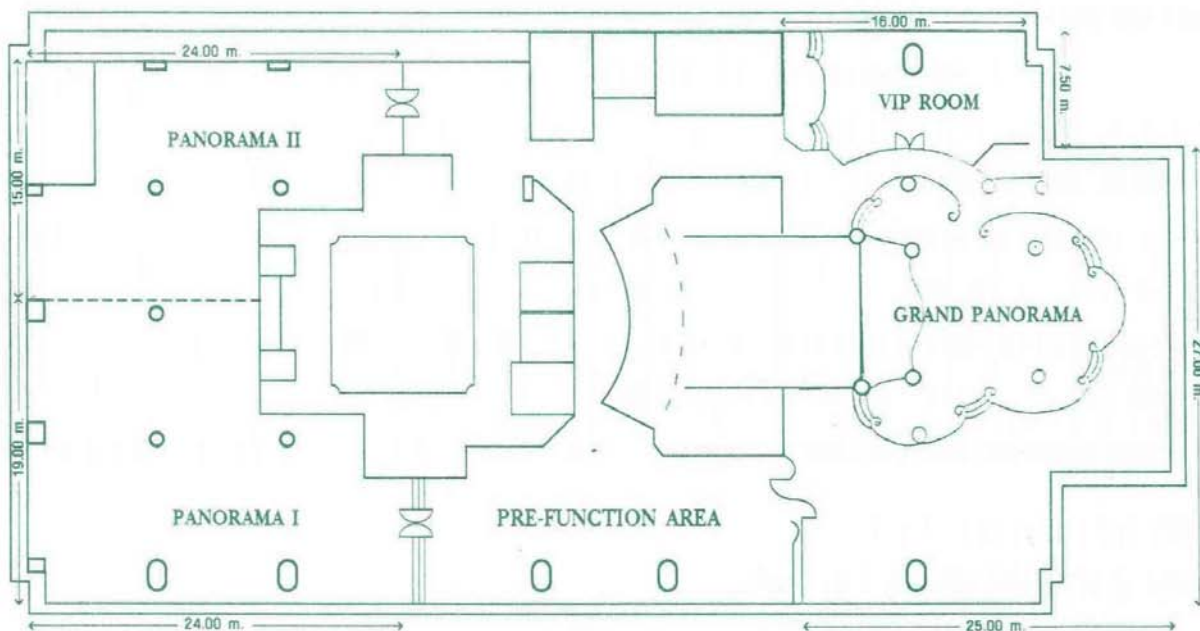
- Please be ready in the session five minutes before the schedule.
